Depending on my need, it could be an excellent tablet, but it is better to put S7+ if you want special applications and you need it. Samsung introduced a good Android tablet from the Galaxy Tab S7+, but the recommended detail price is 899 euros, making it outside the tablet market. If you don't have to have a tablet with Android, it can be a better choice if the iPad Pro should be used as a new animal in the work of the Samsung Galaxy Tab S7+. Starting from August 21, the S7+ sales price in the Netherlands and Belgium has been offered for 899 euros. This price applies to a variant with Wi-Fi connection of 128 GB. If you prefer a tablet with a little more storage space, you will receive a model with a mass of 256 GB and 8 GB for 979 euros.
